The floors had to provide a feel of the surrounding native flora and wildlife, look aesthetically pleasing yet provide long term durability.

The floor area needed to be smooth, easy to clean and durable whilst providing a talking point for visitors to the centre.

The client chose Nuplex to provide a solution.

## NUPLEX Solution

Nuplex Architectural Terrazzite was recommended due to the versatile nature of the product.

Architectural Terrazzite is mixed on site to colours and Patterns as designed by the Architect.

In this instance the “fronds” and the “kiwi footprints” were Precast in Architectural Terrazzite and Laser cut to shape And bonded to the floor followed by the onsite installation of the Architectural Terrazzite.

The floor then goes through various stages of diamond Grinding to expose the marble effect and give a high degree of shine.

This product can transform any space and has a wide range of colour options and patterns only limited by the imagination.

The floor is a striking example of what can be achieved with a little imagination.
